THEME

Organizational toxicity is the widespread, intense, energy-sapping negative emotion that disconnects people from their jobs, co-workers, and organizations.

Painful emotions, like insecurity, envy and anger, arising from events such as unexpected and disruptive changes, or difficult interactions with bosses, colleagues and customers, are inevitably part of organizational life. They become "toxic" when others respond to them in a harmful and destructive ways. Organizational toxicity has pervasive negative effects, undermining individuals' confidence, hope, and self-esteem, and damaging their morale and performance, both at work and outside. Confusion, fragmentation, a culture of blaming, and perverse solutions are just some of the consequences and manifestations of organizational toxicity.





The meeting is aimed at addressing a number of *questions*

AIMS

- What is organizational health?
- How does the organization's health relate to the health of its leadership and of its members?
- How are organizational health and toxicity related to its societal context? Is this relationship reciprocal?
- How do we identify and measure an organization's potential or actual toxicity and the consequences for its functioning?
- What methods do we have for managing, containing, and mitigating organizational toxicity, in order to create a more healthy and resilient organizational culture?




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VENUE
